


LABOR FORCE 12,904




BUSINESSES AND JOBS

INCOME AND SPENDING

Workers in Canton earn a median yearly household income of \$48,948. 38.11% of the households earn more than the national average each year. Household expenditures average \$51,604 per year. The majority of earnings get spent on Shelter, Transportation, Food and Beverages, Health Care, and Utilities.
